National Brain Injury Programs

Annual Survivor Conference:
A national conference fully funded by BIAC. Brings together survivors, families and leaders to plan programs and services for the year.

Hawaiian Oyster Odysseys:
The trademark fundraising program with ten across Canada this year. Also intended to raise the profile of the organization among the community and foster national, provincial and local partnerships.

Prevention Campaign:
In partnership with ThinkFirst Foundation, awareness campaign on milk cartons. Specially intended to make children and parents aware and understand ways to keep themselves safe from brain injuries.

Partnership with brain injury associations in provinces:
Identifying new ways for national and provincial association to work in partnership with the common goal of caring for the brain injured.

Helmet Legislation :
Advocating with government bodies for the introduction of a new legislation that would prevent the sale of helmets in Canada unless it meets the Canadian Standards Association (CSA) guidelines. Legislation would identify those products not making the grade as hazardous.

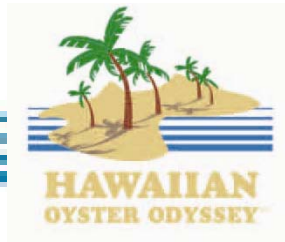
